

# Wrap Company Agreement

Terms for installers in the AdRide network

## 1. The Network

AdRide.us ("AdRide", "we") operates a network of professional wrap installers ("Installer", "you") who receive wrap installation and removal jobs from active AdRide campaigns. There is no fee to join the network.

## 2. Eligibility

To join you must:

- Operate a legitimate wrap / vehicle-graphics business.
- Provide a valid business license.
- Carry general liability insurance and provide proof of coverage.
- Submit a portfolio of prior wrap work when requested.

## 3. Accepting Jobs

AdRide assigns installation and removal jobs in your service area. You confirm availability within the stated window; confirmed jobs must be completed on schedule. Repeated no-shows or late completions may remove you from the network.

## 4. Quality Standards

All work must meet professional trade standards:

- Clean, bubble-free application with wrapped edges per manufacturer guidance.
- Dated photo documentation of completed work uploaded before payment is released.
- Removal jobs must leave the vehicle in pre-wrap condition, normal wear excepted.

## 5. Payment

Payment for completed, photo-verified jobs is released within 10 business days. Rates are agreed per job or per rate card before work begins. You are responsible for your own taxes as an independent contractor.

## 6. Independent Contractor

You operate as an independent contractor, not an employee of AdRide or the Advertiser. You supply your own tools, materials (unless AdRide supplies media), labor, and insurance.

## 7. Termination

Either party may end participation with 15 days' notice. AdRide may end participation immediately for substandard work, missed jobs without notice, or lapsed insurance.

## 9. Governing Terms
